- Determine where water issues will occur and respond in an appropriate manner.
- Supervise and assist with culvert installations and excavations.
- Building both temporary and long term fencing.
- Knowledge with use and handling of dangerous goods as they pertain to beaver dam removal.
- Assist with the maintenance and operation of waste collection sites.
- Monitor the identification, reporting and control of weed, pest, insect and disease control programs for the County.
- Attend regional workshops and training seminars.
