#### **Invest In Your Future Application Form**

The Intention of the "Invest In Your Future" Scholarship is to encourage students to apply for postsecondary education at Portage College and to assist them in offsetting their cost of education. An initial calculation of an Early Assessment Average helps determine from the Grade 11 or Grade 12 marks in certain subject areas what a student may qualify for in terms of an award. Students must be coming directly from high school to a Portage College career program.

# Awards/Scholarships/Bursaries Application Criteria

- 1. Conditions of the award are that you must maintain satisfactory standing and full time attendance.
- 2. You must reside in the Province of Alberta for a minimum of one year prior to the date this application is completed.
- 3. A brief essay outlining community involvement must be submitted with application.
- 4. Must be graduating High School within 100km of the Portage College service region or Portage College students completing College Preparation, with no breaks between study periods.
- 5. According to Revenue Canada tax regulations you must have a Social Insurance Number in order to receive an award. All bursaries are taxable. You will automatically be issued a T4A if you are a recipient.
- 6. Only successful applicants will be notified. All documents submitted become the property of Portage College and will not be returned.
- 7. Your personal information provided on this application will only be used for the purposes as outlined in the Declaration of Applicant.
- 8. All financial obligations to the College must be settled before a cash award, scholarship or bursary is released.

- Attach ALL documents asked for (i.e. do you need to supply a statement of marks or transcript?)

#### Category A:

The final mark for English 30, English 30-1 or English 30-2. It is mandatory to include this mark.

# **Category B:**

Use the three best final marks from your best subject areas listed. Use 20-Level marks if you are registered in, but have not yet completed the 30-Level course in any given subject area. High final 20 level or 30 level for final.

# Category C:

Use the one best additional Grade 12 subject mark. A Grade 11 final mark may be used provided you are registered to take the subject at the Grade 12 level (5 credit). You may use a Category B subject if it was not used in that Category. A 30-Level course mark maybe used as long as it is not the same as a subject used in Caregory B (i.e. Social Studies 33 may be used if Social Studies 30 was not used in Category B). The average of two 3-credit Grade 12 subject marks may be used in place of a 5-credit subject. Can include Phys Ed 30 but Special Projects or Work Experience cannot be included.

Portage College uses five subjects to calculate your High School Average. The subjects required are:

- English
- 3 other academic subjects
- An approved fifth subject

# What is the value of the academic scholarship?

## **Merit Scholarship**

To qualify you must have an average between 60-69%. 4 scholarships are available with a value of \$400.

#### **Recognition Scholarship**

To qualify you must have an average between 70-79%. 2 scholarships are available with a value of \$800.

## **Honors Scholarship**

To qualify you must have an average between 80-89%. 2 scholarships are available with a value of \$1,200.

Scholarships selections will be made in October.
