- Currently registered with the Alberta College of Paramedics as an Advanced Care Paramedic (ACP) or Primary Care Paramedic (PCP). Preference will be given to Advanced Care Paramedics or 2nd year Advanced Care Paramedic Students.
- Hold a valid Class 4 drivers licence and can provide a driver's abstract demonstrating six demerits or fewer.
- Have the ability to successfully obtain, and maintain, a vulnerable sector police information check.
- Ability to pass medical standards, including eyesight and audible, as outlined in the NFPA standard.

- Valid Class 3 drivers license and Air Brake (Q) endorsement
