The Home Support Case Worker job is located in Lac La Biche, a hamlet in northern Alberta (220 km NE of Edmonton) is responsible for facilitating planned interventions and services for the purposes of strengthening and preserving families. This includes home-based, family-centered services designed to promote the protection and well-being of children in their homes, as well as educating parents and providing tools to improve parenting abilities. The Home Support Case Worker reports to the Program Manager – Lac La Biche Family Service Centre.

In the role of Home Support Case Worker you will:

- Establish trusting relationships with families who are referred to WJS Canada for support.
- Travel to families' homes within Lac La Biche to provide one-on-one in home support up to 6 hours per shift providing hands on parenting skills, routine management and childcare supervision.
- Help families connect with community resources and support networks to enhance family functioning.
- Provide emotional support to family members through construction of interpersonal relationships.
- Follow prescribed case management plans.
- Transport individuals or families to appointments as required.
- Administrative duties including typing/filing reports, compiling monthly reports, etc.

****All applicants must provide a current (within 3 months) Criminal Record Check and Ministry Check prior to confirmation of employment with WJS Canada. These checks can take up to 6 weeks to obtain, please prepare accordingly.**

As an ideal candidate for the Home Support Case Worker position you possess:

- High School Diploma with related social work, family intervention, human services or childcare experience.
- Valid Alberta Driver's License, reliable vehicle with appropriate insurance, and clean driver's abstract
- Clear criminal record check and Child Intervention check
- Valid CPR/First Aid and WHMIS
- Training in suicide prevention and cultural sensitivity
