ABOUT THE POSITION

- Adult teaching/tutoring experience would be considered beneficial.
- Excellent communication and organizational skills and the ability to work with minimal supervision.
- Knowledge or experience with Moodle or other Learning Management System would be an asset.
- Strong computer skills, especially with MS Office, is essential.
- Some travel and a flexible schedule is required for organizing and supervising practicum visits.
- Successful applicant will be required to provide a current police information check and driver's abstract.
