Duties:

- Provide hands-on services and implement weed inspection/pesticide application, pest and nuisance wildlife control, and all other ASB Programs.
- Monitor the identification, reporting and control of weed, pest, insect and disease control programs for the County.
- Assist with the maintenance and operation of waste collection sites.
- Assist in beaver related flooding issues and beaver dam removal.
- Attend regional workshops and training seminars.

- Conduct pest and weed surveys.
