Pay rates are based on position classification, starting at \$19.94 per hour for Administrative Support roles and up to \$30.17 per hour for Natural Resources roles.

Terms of Employment

Employment periods range from May to September 2025.

What We Offer:

- Competitive Compensation: Wage employees receive an additional 11.2% on top of regular earnings in lieu of paid holidays and vacation leave:
 - o 5.2% instead of paid holidays.
 - o 6% instead of annual vacation leave.
- **Shift Differential:** Opportunities for overtime, evening, and weekend shifts.
- Premium Pay Allowances:
 - o Employees residing above the 57th Parallel (e.g., High Level) receive a biweekly Northern Allowance of \$241.38.
 - o Employees in the Fort McMurray Area receive a biweekly allowance of \$478.17 (prorated for part-time employees).
- Cultural Awareness and Support: We recognize the significance of Indigenous cultural practices and will work with employees to ensure they have the flexibility and support needed to participate in ceremonies, traditions, and other cultural commitments.
- A supportive and inclusive team environment that values diverse perspectives and skills.
- Training opportunities, including orientation and on-the-job skills development.
- Opportunities to contribute to Alberta Parks' commitment to Truth and Reconciliation, fostering meaningful relationships with Indigenous communities.
