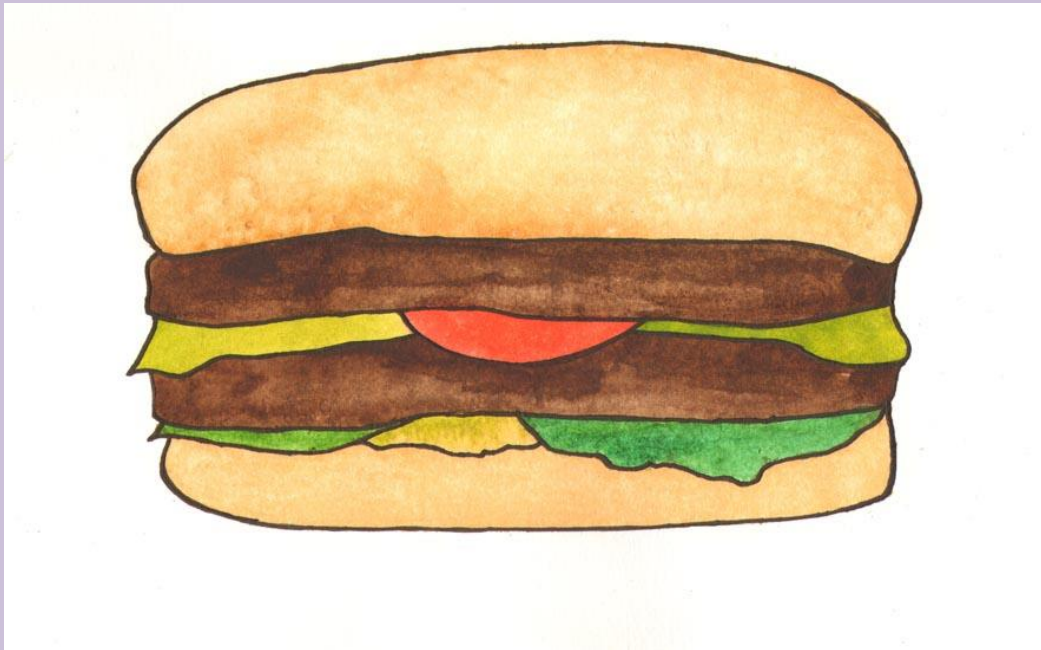


# The Hamburger Essay Plan

Gather all your ingredients – information that you have researched, class and seminar notes, readings.....now assemble the burger in the process illustrated on the next page down.

**Top bun: the introduction**
